**Kanon Book Review:** The song of a wanderer is an excellent evangelistic book. It is written by a Chinese author who grew up with many of the atheistic beliefs that many of the Chinese people share. God worked in his life and over a long period of time he finally came to a belief in God and decided to trust in the Gospel. This book is a series of well thought out and polite arguments showing there is a God that does exist and that he will save people that will trust in Him for salvation. It gives reasons why there is a God that does exist, why the Bible is the words of God, why Christianity is the one true religion, why Jesus' resurrection was a real event, and why Christianity is true compared to science and evolution. The book ends with a detailed presentation of the Gospel. I liked the book and would give it a very good review. It is an apologetic style book, but isn't too argumentative and stays focused on the Gospel. It does not try to go too deep into psychology and arguments. Instead, the book simply tries to present people with the truth and give them the choice to believe it. It is a book that is especially good to give away to unbelievers or new Christians, because it deals with many of the questions about God that many people want to know about. Because of this an older believer may find some of the book simply telling him things he already knows, but I still think there will be many parts of the book that he finds helpful. My favorite part of the book was the chapter that gave the evidences for the truth of the resurrection. I think you will enjoy this book and I give it a very good recommendation.
